For the Sabacc trump cards, I factored in the Lucas-produced decks and the cards mentioned in the Legends novels, matching any unnumbered trump cards with the Tarot trump cards with the closest meaning (red text in the "Novels" column in the table. Then, I filled any gaps with the remaining Rider-Waite Tarot cards, resulting in the trump cards in the final column in the table (blue text indicates the final reconstructed cards).

The only card in the Rider-Waite Tarot deck I was not happy with was "The Hierophant" (card -5). Hierophant is a word that's just not used in modern English. It equates to a pope or religious guide. I've replaced it with "The Jedi Master" in the card list.

This fits in with the LucasArts Sabacc deck created for Celebration Anaheim in 2015, and with all L. Neil Smith's Lando Calrissian novels, and with Vonda N. McIntyre's *The Crystal Star*. The only novel that doesn't fit is Claudia Gray's *Bloodline*, in which "The Star" has a value of -10. This contradicts the earlier Lucas-produced Sabacc decks and also the Rider-Waite Tarot deck, which has a "The Star" card and values it at 17 (which is -17 in Sabacc).
